South Philadelphia High School GOALS

- 1. At least 75% of 9th grade students will be on track to earn a minimum of 5 quality credits each marking period.*
- 2. Increase the number of students scoring proficient or advanced on the Literature Keystone by 8%.*
- 3. At least 90% of 9th grade students will have 0 out of school suspensions.*
- 4. At least 50% of students will attend 95% of days or more.*
- 5. At least 95% of 12th grade students will be on track for graduation.*

Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress.
Provide parents with reasonable access to staff.
Provide parents with opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

We, as parents, will:

Acknowledge that I/we have viewed or a copy of the teachers' syllabi for each class on their child's roster/schedule.
Participate in "Back to School Night" and attend a parent-teacher conference when offered by the School and/or its Teachers.
Stay informed about my child's education (i.e. grades through Parent Portal) and communicate with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district either received by my child or by mail and responding, as appropriate.
Provide and update my email and phone information in order to provide a platform for teachers and school staff to keep me informed.
Volunteer in my child's classroom, attend school events, and participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my child's education.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

Do my homework every day and ask for help when I need it.
Read, sign, and keep a copy of my teachers' syllabi for each class on my roster
Read at least 30 minutes every day outside of school time.
Give to my parents or guardian all notices and information from school.
Take advantage of after-school tutoring programs.
Come to school every day on time.
Be respectful to all.
